CORE Sports Hawai'i is celebrating 10 years in Kapolei and 5 years in Honolulu. What began as a single clinic with 13 employees has grown into two thriving locations with a team of 32. The journey hasn't been easy for Dana and Shaun, but through determination, grit, and the support of a hardworking, resilient staff, CORE has become what they envisioned—a therapeutic space where the O'ahu community feels like family.





FINDING THE RIGHT TEAM

Dana and Shaun grew up immersed in healthcare and educational administrative environments, gaining valuable experience through various jobs and internships. As employees themselves, they've worked under a range of management styles and have seen firsthand both the pitfalls and strengths of different leadership approaches. These experiences shaped a core belief that guides CORE's culture today: building a successful team starts with hiring people with heart. Team members must have a genuine desire to help others, a commitment to continuous learning, and a strong spirit of collaboration. Above all, they must truly care—about their patients, their coworkers, and the greater mission CORE serves in the community.



NOTHING COMES EASY

In 2015, just one month into operations, a disastrous sewage flood destroyed the entire clinic. Dana and Shaun thought their dream had ended before it truly began. But with the support of their loyal staff, local businesses like PuroClean, and their good friend Weylin Sasaki leading the reconstruction, they managed to flush out the setback and rebuild with a renewed sense of purpose. Some called it a cleansing sign. For Dana and Shaun, it was just another bump in the road—one they were determined to drive over. They believed CORE Sports was worth fighting for. They never gave up. They understood that nothing worth having comes easy. Every setback became a setup for a comeback—a belief that mirrors the rehab journey for their patients. Rehab isn't easy. It takes grit, hard work, and persistence. But if you want better outcomes, you have to earn them. CORE has weathered many challenges over the years, but none greater than 2020. Like many small businesses, it was a test of resilience and unity. Dana and Shaun were proud of their team for standing strong trusting in the protocols, the plans, and most importantly, in the shared dream of sustaining a therapeutic space that feels like family.
